Through practical exercises, interactive sessions, and discussions, participants will build skills for effective engagement and learn approaches that foster better understanding during misunderstandings and conflicts.

## This workshop aims to:

- Promote ecumenical dialogue and mutual respect among young people from various Christian traditions.
- Explore themes of identity, resilience, empathy, and inclusion—topics that are particularly relevant for youth facing today's challenges in Ukraine.
- Practice dialogue skills, active listening, and peacebuilding tools.
- Explore how young people can make an impact in their communities—through peacebuilding, initiatives, and ministry.
- Develop a support network among young Christians from different traditions who are committed to contributing to positive social change.





Together, we will explore key topics such as:

- Dialogue
- Ecumenism
- Identity
- Inner and collective resilience
- Conflict: understanding, transformation, effective engagement
- Building a shared vision for the future

# Who can apply?

- Young people aged 18–26
- Representatives of various Christian traditions
- Active participants in church or community life
- Individuals open to ecumenical dialogue

In order to create a group that becomes a source of mutual learning, the selection process will take into account geographic, gender, age, and denominational diversity.
